BULLYING


We often think of children as innocent, angelic creatures, we perceive childhood as a beautiful, idyllic time filled with fun and play. While this can and perhaps should be true, there is also a darker face to childhood. In a wicked world, children too can be cruel, traumatising another sometimes for life.

While we celebrate Children's day this issue by presenting the beautiful artistic and literary expressions of children from S.E.T. schools (Pg.12), as adults we deemed it equally important to bring out a darker slice of this very determining phase of human life.

We wish to address the problem of bullying that lurks in schools and neighbourhoods, one that is more serious than we might think only so that it may be tackled and life for children may be restored to what it should be.

To start with, bullying is unwanted, aggressive behaviour by children towards other children due to a real or perceived power imbalance. The behaviour is repeated, or has the potential to be repeated, over time.

Types of Bullying



* Multiple types of bullying can be selected.

Types of bullying include verbal bullying such as—name calling, insulting, making comments and threatening; physical bullying like hitting, pushing, damaging or snatching away property and stealing. In worst cases physical bullying can also involve use of weapons. Social bullying can involve spreading rumours, ignoring and exclusion. Cyber bullying can take place in the form of posting homophobic, sexual or racially insulting comments or images, threats etc..on the social medias or over messages on cell phones.

Both kids who are bullied and who bully others may have serious, lasting problems.

Effects of Bullying



Bullied children can suffer from depression, anxiety, panic attacks, physical injury, lack of interest, trust issues, decreased academic performance and low self-esteem. They can also resort to self-mutilation, substance abuse and have suicidal thoughts.

Another damaging repercussion is bullying is often cyclical. Students who have been bullied can, in an attempt to gain their power and self-esteem back, become school bullies themselves.

The Bully

Coming to the bullies themselves, they dominate, blame, use and target others and don't accept the consequences of their actions. They lack empathy and foresight and have contempt for others they perceive as weak, which in truth is a display of their own vulnerability.

Bullies who are not confronted or stopped may find themselves in future positions where they can bully as adults. This is where manipulative bosses, violent spouses and child abusers come from.

However, it is important to realise they are victims too. Bullying might be a result of loneliness and a cry for attention which they may lack.

Research has shown that bullies are a consequence of negative parenting traits such as-a destructive emotional attitude, lack of warmth and involvement, extremely authoritative parenting, physical punishment etc..

Thus, bullies may also just be imitating adult role-models who display angry, aggressive behaviour and don't handle conflict well. These people may be -parents, relatives, teachers, coaches, television and other media.

Bullies too suffer poor academic performance, and can resort to substance abuse. Children who have witnessed bullying too suffer.

Keeping these things in mind it is important to handle both the bully and the bullied with utmost care.


Tackling the Problem

It is important that the problem of bullying is tackled on various levels. Parents, teachers, counsellors and institutions can all come together to rectify the bully and empower the bullied.

Here are some handy tips to deal with the issue: Physical and emotional safety of students must be the top most priority of institutions. Therefore, it is extremely important for institutions to take steps towards tackling bullying.

Concerned authorities must make it clear to students that bullying is not allowed on campus. Teachers can be sensitised to understand the background of students, their peer group and other issues concerning them. Teachers must let students know that they are approachable and that they can be relied upon for help. Schools can also stress to parents the need to provide children not only a physical but also an emotionally healthy, stable environment at home. Institutions may take the help of professional counsellors and also install suggestion boxes where students can report incidents. The campus may also be put under C.C.T.V. surveillance and one must not hesitate to involve authorities in extreme cases. Students may also be sensitised regarding the issue through movie screenings, role-play and visiting rehabs etc...

Helping the Victim

- Empower the victim to help themselves
- Build confidence, assertiveness and better coping mechanisms with warmth and affection
- Let them know they are not alone
- Encourage them to develop their talents and boost their self-esteem

What not to tell a child getting bullied

- Don't tell the child to ignore the bully, the bully may take it as a need to intensify the assault.
- Don't tell the child to fight back, the school may not see it as self-defense and the child may get further penalised.
- Do not deal with the bully's parents directly, don't be accusing, they may feel affronted, use a mediator.

Helping the Bully

- Appreciate and reinforce positive behaviour
- Set realistic goals, don't expect overnight change
- Assure the child that they are loved and you only want to help them
- Communicate that it is only the behaviour that is unpleasant and needs to be changed
- Channelise aggression into some sport or outdoor activity
- Counsel the parent; ensure the child has a healthy home environment

Remember

Never be bullied into silence. Never allow yourself to be made a victim. Accept no one's definition of your life, but define you.


